Estimates for 2019-2021 are preliminary. There is a break in the series between 2016 og 2017 due to re-evaluation of the weights. Therefore, it's not advised to compare counts before and after 2017.

Unit:

Household rate (%): The results come from Statistics on Income and Living condition survey (SILC). The general research unit in SILC is the household. The sample is drawn on a random basis from the National Registry of Persons. The selected respondent provides all information about the living condition of the household, their own conditions and the conditions of all other household members. Here the data is analysed at the household level.

Indicator:

Poor housing conditions: The index is calculated as the percentage of respondents that experience problems with their housing because of a leaking roof and/or damp ceilings, dampness in the walls, floors or foundation and/or rot in window frames and doors.

Overcrowding: The overcrowding rate is defined as the percentage of the population living in an overcrowded household. A person is considered as living in an overcrowded household if the household does not have at its disposal a minimum number of rooms equal to: one room for the household; one room per couple in the household; one room for each single person aged 18 or more; one room per pair of single people of the same gender between 12 and 17 years of age; one room for each single person between 12 and 17 years of age and not included in the previous category; one room per pair of children under 12 years of age.
